The mission of MCA is to offer the children of the community a firm foundation in their education experience in a Christian based environment. We believe that each child should be introduced to the learning experience in a manner that will promote and encourage the joy of learning and knowledge that will continue throughout their lives. Intrinsic to the education experience at MCA is the knowledge that Christ is Lord and Savior.

MCA Preschool Classes ages 2-4:

All classes have a dedicated teacher and teacher assistant in the room.

All classes participate in a weekly music and movement class.

All classes participate in monthly Chapel program and special programs throughout the school year.

All students receive a book bag and MCA t-shirt at the beginning of the school year.

MCA uses an active teaching method that includes art, cooking, song, etc. to enhance the learning process.

All classes use an embellished Wee Learn Curriculum for academics and the Journey curriculum for the Christian teachings.

All classes have mid-morning snacks and outdoor supervised free play or inside in the gym in inclement weather.

Each class time includes one-on-one activities with the teacher, group activities and circle time.

Each class participates in service projects that promote Christian values in the community or among other children.

Four Year Old Classes:

The emphasis of the curriculum is letters, numbers, writing, fine motor skill development, social skill development and overall preparation for Kindergarten.

Units of study include areas of science, social studies, and literature.

All classes have separate instruction time for Computers each week.

All classes have enrichment teachers either weekly or monthly for additional instruction in literature, math skills building, listening skills and science.

Field trips are included to enhance current and past units of study.

Three Year Old Classes:

The emphasis of the curriculum is introduction to letter and number recognition, review of colors and shapes, social skill development and fine motor skill development.

Units of study include areas of science, social studies and literature.

The five day class receives weekly computer instruction and monthly enrichment instruction in literature and listening skills.

Two Year Old Classes:

The emphasis of the curriculum is social skill development, fine motor skill development and color and shape recognition. There is limited introduction to letters and numbers. A nursery rhyme curriculum is used to teach various elements of the curriculum.

Units of study include areas of social studies, science, and literature.
